

TV GLIDE final show details.

We are in the home stretch before our ice show. Coaches are adding the final touches to routines on Sat. 2/24 before our dress rehearsal that will be held Fri. 3/1 @ 6:00 pm. Keep in mind we may call an extra rehearsal the morning of the show on Sat. 3/1 for any groups that need extra rehearsal time before the show in the morning 8:45-9:45 am during open freestyle time. We will let groups know during dress rehearsal if your group will need an extra practice.

Dress Rehearsal

3/1/24 Fri. Dress rehearsal wear all costumes, full make up, hair, tights.

Locker room assignments scroll down in the document

ALL SKATERS THAT HAVE QUICK CHANGES WILL NEED TO WEAR A THIN SPAGHETTI STRAP LEOTARD UNDER THEIR COSTUME, No changing down to your undergarments unless you're covered by a thin leotard. Male skaters will need to change in the restroom skates on the bench near the players box. It's very important at dress rehearsal to do all costume changes so you can practice the changes. Please practice at home this week as well. Team & Soloist PVC Pipes & Back drops can be assembled at 5:30 pm please have them ready to go in show order by 6:00 pm

Fri. 3/1 Dress rehearsal Skaters

5:30 pm Arrive dressed in the first costume you wear in the show, skates on meet at the ice **6 pm SHARP!!!** The crew will be hanging the curtain at this time while we are teaching the skaters the finale.

6:00-6:30 pm all skaters fully dressed we will teach you the finale on the ice.

6:30 pm full run through of the show. We will run the first and second half of the show straight through with no intermission during dress rehearsal. We will not practice the adult/high school/junior instructor, or graduating Sr. introductions. Those will take place at after intermission on show day.

Reminder on show day Sat. after the 1st half everyone needs to get dressed in their 2nd half costume all Adult, High School, Junior Instructors, and graduating Seniors will need to be ready to take the ice as soon as the Zamboni is finished we will present the instructors/seniors at that time.

5:15 pm Backstage crew arrive special instructions from Tim

5:30 pm Back stage crew hang & set up curtain with Tim

6:00 pm Back stage crew set up props back stage in order that they will be used in the show. (skaters will be learning & practicing the finale 6-6:30 pm you can still set up)-(Sat. Show day backstage crew will need to hang black plastic & twinkle lights as well as the curtain & preset all the props)

6:30 pm Spotlights & props on the ice ready to run all routines with announcer from top of the show to the end of the show.

5:30 pm spotlight volunteers arrive

5:45 pm Spotlight volunteers meeting with Jonathan Palmersten

6:15 pm Spotlight volunteers be ready to turn on spotlights when we run through the finale. After we run the finale we will run the entire show from beginning to end with no intermission at dress rehearsal. (skaters will be learning & practicing the finale 6-6:30 pm we will need you to run spotlights 6:15 pm when we are ready to run the finale 6:30 pm show starts-8:30 pm)

3/2 Sat. ICE SHOW DAY!!!

8:30-10:30 am

- Front of house volunteers-Tracy Bible, Tiffany Eschenbach, Amanda Jacobs, Kim Wald are needed in the morning as well as any other parents hanging out at the arena that can give an extra hand. Front of house assistants decorate lobby ceiling, assemble flowers for Adult, High School & Jr. Instructors that we will give to the skaters at intermission of the show when we present them, blow up balloons with pumps in the Girls Varsity Locker Room. Flowers & Balloons will need to be stay in the girls varsity locker room. Please put the flowers in a bucket with water. Anna will be making a balloon arch after practice on Saturday @ 11:30-12:30 am if any of the moms can stay to help.
- Karena Rother is creating the business sponsor table but we will need one of our front of house lobby decorators to put them on the table in the lobby the evening of the show along side the ice show framed photos and Senior featured soloists.
- See Kate to purchase your skater a "skater wish" on our skater wish wall- we sell these for skaters in lieu of flowers. Friends/family members can write a special note for their skater and display it on the skater wish wall in the lobby at the show. See Kate Mikonowicz for these items show morning. They will be sold in the lobby on show night as well cash only. We will give the well wishes to each skater that their family/friends wrote to them at the end of the show. We will also have a photo booth at the front of house for guests to take photos at. We will also have one back stage for the kids to take photos by be sure to hast tag #RiverBladesSkatingSchool

3/2 Sat. Show day evening schedule skaters & volunteers

Tickets are \$10 cash additional keepsake programs are \$12 at the door

4:45 pm Front of house arrive to set up tables, table cloth, photos, sponsorship table, ticket/program/wish sales area, skater wish wall, swag bag table, photo booth in the lobby & back stage. Spectators start arriving around 6:00 pm we want to be ready when they arrive. I need two front of house volunteers to hand out swag bags & skater wall wishes right at the end of the show (Jackie Willms?)

5:00 pm All back stage crew arrive & hang the curtain and black plastic. We have from 5-6 pm to set up, soloists will be practicing at designated times while you hang curtain/hang plastic & twinkle lights. Place Balloon towers on the ice after the Zamboni @ 6:15 pm

6:00-6:15 pm Zamboni

6:15 pm Spotlight Operators arrive & meet Jonathan for instructions

6:15 pm Place ALL props Balloon towers & Balloon arch on the ice

6:30 pm Doors open to the public to find seats.

(Back stage crew please remember to add some rope lighting back stage so the kids can see behind the curtain, as well as in the stair wells for guests due to the limited lighting once the show starts)

Schedule for soloists and group skaters

Soloist Schedule before show for warm up

5:00 pm Soloists can get in to locker rooms

5:15-5:30 pm 1st half Soloists warm up ice

5:30-5:45 pm 2nd half Soloist warm up ice

5:45-6:00 pm Senior Soloists & guest skater warm up ONLY

6:00-6:15 pm Zamboni

All group skaters arrive on show day

5:45 pm All skaters arrive dressed in first costume, hair and make up ready to go. Put skates on in locker rooms see locker room assignments that are on the Mcgree rink.

6:45 pm ALL SKATERS in the first four routines line up back stage

7:00 pm Show starts

7:45 pm Intermission please be sure skaters that are adult/high school/junior instructors/Senior Soloists are dressed in their second half costume and take the ice after the Zamboni for the Instructor & Senior recognition.

ALL SKATERS ARE IN THE FINALE

Skaters should be down at ice level lined up **4 routines** before they perform and before the finale.

Skaters seating area-Young skaters can sit with parents if they have their costume covered with a robe however be careful wearing skates in the stands it's very easy to slip and fall on the stands.

We have a skater seating area that parents can sit with their skater until they perform. This is not chaperoned. Wear skate guards & remember to take them off before taking the ice.

BE SURE TO MARK ALL OF YOUR ITEMS WITH YOUR SKATERS NAME IN CASE SOMETHING GOES MISSING.

ON-Ice Cast Photo after the show!!! Please have your skater stay on the ice for all cast photo under the spotlights. Parents & family feel free to take pictures from the ends of the ice and the stands or come down to ice level for photos.
